## STALKING – GENDER ISSUES

94% of female victims were stalked by men.

60% of male victims were stalked by men.

Overall, 87% of stalkers were men.

**Most female victims are stalked by some type of intimate partner:**

38% of women are stalked by current or former husbands;

10% of women are stalked by current or former cohabiting partners;

14% of women are stalked by current or former dates or boyfriends.

Only 23% of female stalking victims are stalked by strangers.

81% of stalking victims who were stalked by an intimate partner reported that they had also been physically assaulted by that partner.

31% were also sexually assaulted by that partner.
